TESOL Press seeks an author for a new product in its <u>TESOL No-Prep Activity Cards</u> series, which is geared toward English language teachers who are looking for classroom activities that require little to no preparation.

The author will write 100 extremely brief tasks/activities related to specific language skills using AI as a tool to obtain a language objective. Activities should

- include individual, pair, group, and whole class work;
- include elements of prompt engineering and output analysis; and
- be appropriate for A2+ proficiency levels, and for teens and adults.

  - o reading, writing, speaking, listening.

Each sample activity should be no more than 200 words; no visuals or images included.
