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## **TESOL Creates New Justice and Equity Professional Council**

Alexandria, Va. (July 29, 2024) – TESOL has created a professional council that will advance the association's commitment to social justice and diversity, equity, inclusion, and access (DEIA) and to help ensure member needs are being met. Based upon the recommendations of TESOL's Diversity Task Force and DEIA working group, the board approved the creation of the Justice and Equity Professional Council (JEPC) at their board meeting in March 2024 and adopted the council's charter in June.

Elisabeth Chan, TESOL board member and chair of the DEIA working group, said, "I'm glad to see TESOL make a systemic commitment to DEIA in the form of a professional council. It builds on the amazing work of our volunteer members who have dedicated their expertise and provided guidance on how the association may make strides in enhancing equity and inclusion. This step is about taking a real look at all TESOL does and making changes that will benefit everyone and support the association into the future."
