TESOL Press is seeking proposals for its English Language Teacher Development (ELTD) series for 15,000-word books on the following topics:

- Social-emotional learning (SEL) in English language teaching
- English-medium instruction (EMI) for language teachers

Authors should be language educators who are emerging or experienced in their topic areas.

Proposal Guidelines

The proposal must include the following:

- CV
- Cover letter, including full mailing address, a daytime and evening telephone number, and email address
- A 500-word summary of the proposed topic that includes:
 - Explanation of theoretical issues
 - o Translation of theories into classroom practice
 - A sample of reflection questions
 - o References and Further Reading

Proposals will be judged on the appropriateness for the series format.
