- be written in an informal voice
- be submitted monthly, according to a predetermined schedule
- be subject to editing for grammar, length, and style

- a brief cover letter
- 10 sample titles (each title should be 60 characters or fewer, including spaces, and should accurately reflect the content of the post)
- one sample posting, with title: An example posting that is representative of your general blog content (700 words or fewer)
- a brief author bio (100 words or fewer)

This call is open until the position is filled.

TESOL will contact only those applicants whose credentials best suit blogger requirements.
