Example Words (Nautical Story Theme)

Team A: schooner, gull

Team B: catamaran, buoy

Dubious Definitions (Team Created)

- Schooner: A captain of a merchant ship that has more than 10 years of experience. (noun)
- Catamaran: A type of anchor needed for deep water. (noun)
- Gull: An organ on the body that allows fish to breathe. (noun)
- Buoy: A name given to a baby whale or other mammals that live in salt water. (noun)

True Definitions (Retrieved from Wordhippo)

- Schooner: A sailing ship with two or more masts, all with fore-and-aft sails; if two masted, having a foremast and a mainmast. (noun)
- Catamaran: A twin-hulled ship or boat. (noun)
- Gull: A seabird of the genus *Larus* or of the family *Laridae* (noun)
- Buoy: A float moored in water to mark a location, warn of danger, or indicate a navigational channel. (noun)
